

Alberta's Occupational Health and Safety Act

What farm and ranch workers need to know

If you're a waged worker on a farm or ranch and are not related to your employer by blood, marriage or adoption, or are not in an adult interdependent relationship with them, you have rights and responsibilities under the law.



You have the right to refuse dangerous work.



You have the right to participate in health and safety decisions.



You have the right to know about work site hazards.



If something goes wrong and you get sick or injured on the job, you must report what happened to your employer as soon as possible.

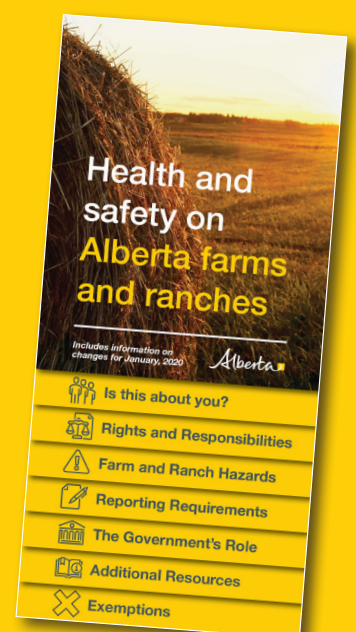
