Topics and competencies are set out as line items in the application form. The medical advisor must verify that <u>every</u> topic and competency level in the course materials meet the standard. OHS will not review or approve applications with missing topics or competency levels.
Medical advisor signs the application form.	Signature confirms the medical advisor's review and that the course materials meet the standard's requirements.
Attach a course certificate template that follows clause 7.10 of CSA Standard Z1210-17, and gives the course name.	The course name on the certificate must match the course name in the application form and on the agency's website.

Do not include course materials with the application.

How to submit your application: Use the OHS <u>Acceptances and Approvals</u> secure online feature. You can enter and upload all required information directly, and track the status of your application.
