## IF YOUR COURSE IS A BLENDED ONLINE COURSE:

Blended online course approvals include Part A, B and C of the First Aid (FA) form with the additional Blended Online Form - Part C that is specific to blended courses.

Blended online courses must incorporate practical skills demonstrations. The minimum duration for these demonstrations is outlined in CSA Standard Z1210-17 (R 2021), Clause 4.4.2. Students' practical skills must be evaluated by an instructor at the end of the in-person practical skills demonstrations, to ensure that required workplace first aid competencies have been demonstrated.

There is no minimum time for completing online e-learning modules, however students taking an online blended course must complete the course within 90 days of starting their first online module. In order to verify learning retention, each online learning module must end with a quiz that must be correctly completed before the student can proceed to the next module

**NOTE**: You must submit a separate workplace first aid review form for each course that your agency teaches, including blended online courses. Your medical advisor must review <u>each course</u> and verify that it meets the requirements of CSA Standard Z1210-17 (R 2021).

Workplace first aid courses (including blended online) must incorporate the minimum practical skills demonstration durations listed in CSA Standard Z1210-17 (R 2021), Clause 4.4.2.
