IF YOUR COURSE IS A RECERTIFICATION COURSE:

Recertification courses must ensure that students demonstrate all required competencies at the appropriate levels. Recertification courses must include both the theory and practical examinations. Recertification courses must be taken prior to a workplace first aider's certificate expiry. After the certificate expiry date, the student must take the full course.

NOTE: You must submit a separate first aid form for each course that your agency teaches, including recertification courses. Your medical advisor must review **each course** and verify that it meets the requirements of CSA Standard Z1210-17 (R 2021).

Workplace first aid courses (including recertification courses) must incorporate the minimum practical skills demonstration durations listed in CSA Standard Z1210-17 (R 2021), Clause 4.4.2.
